aquaponics

Aquaponics combines the principles of aquaculture and hydroponics, without the use of chemicals.

Organic vegetables can be grown highly efficiently while filtering the nutrient rich pond water.

Fish, yabbies, mussels etc grown in the closed system provide a renewable food source and are interesting to watch grow.

With 10% of the water usage and five times the growth rate of a conventional garden, fingerling fish can be grown to plate size in under 12 months.
